I do want to clarify one point. Our original announcement reported that this mini-coin was made from a special lot of silver containing metal that traveled to the moon and back on Apollo 14. It also stated that the silver actually landed on the moon.

The first statement was quite correct. But we have recently learned that the second statement was incorrect. We have been advised that the medals on Apollo 14 did not actually land on the moon's surface, but remained aboard the command module as it circled the moon.

Since this silver did travel to the moon, your mini-coin is still a collector's item you can treasure.
