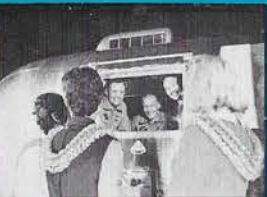

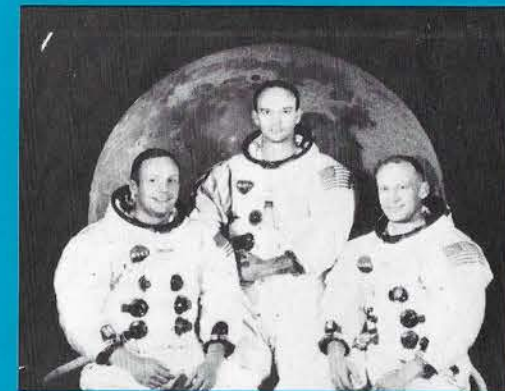

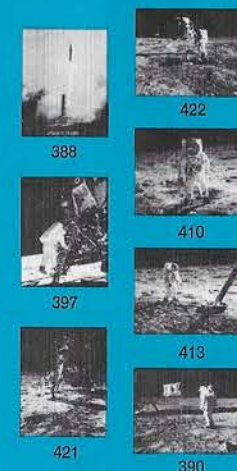
435—A close-up view of the first sample return container opened in the Vacuum Laboratory on Saturday, July 26, 1969.
