



**A** SOLITARY flag marks man's loneliest outpost—238,840 miles from earth. Around it, the imprint of mankind's first faltering step on another world. The Moon photo—15 millions have been waiting for since the return of America's three lunarnauts last week were released yesterday. This one, taken from inside the lunar module, underlines the stark emptiness of the Sea of Tranquillity, where Neil Armstrong and Edwin Aldrin moonhopped for more than two hours. In its airless environment Old Glory droops listlessly from a hidden wire, which stretches it out from the 8ft. tall, gold-coloured staff, planted firmly in the lunar dust.
